POSITION: CASE MANAGER / SUD NAVIGATOR

DUTIES: Under supervision of the Program Manager and Clinical Supervisor, the Case Manager / SUD Navigator will work collaboratively with the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department to provide the clinical SUD and COD services, and comprehensive Case Management services, to the gay and transgender population at Men's Central Jail in Downtown Los Angeles

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A.A. or B.A. degree in a social service field (psychology, sociology, social work) and/or criminology, education, criminal justice administration or political science degree required.
- Certification through C.A.A.D.E. or C.C.A.P.P. *preferred but not necessarily required*
- Minimum of two years' of experience in a licensed treatment facility working with clients with SUD or COD
- Proponent of client-centered, trauma informed, culturally appropriate, recovery oriented system of care.
- Experience with evidence based practices including but not limited to:
Cognitive behavioral Therapy, Motivational Interviewing and Moral Recognition Therapy
- Experience working with LGBTQ community *preferred but not necessarily required*.
- Experience working with the post-incarcerated or incarcerated populations *preferred but not necessarily required*.
- Bilingual (Spanish speaking) *preferred but not necessarily required*.
- Ability to collaborate with integrated, multi-disciplinary team, including but not limited to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, Los Angeles County Department of Health Services, Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, and other mental and behavioral health professionals.
- Effective verbal and written communication skills.
- Computer literacy, including knowledge of Microsoft Word, Outlook and Excel;
- Must submit and pass a background check by the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department.
- CPR and First Aid Certification.
- Physical clearance including T.B. test.
