## Custody to Community Reentry Program (CCTRP)

### *A Place of Women for Empowerment and Recovery*

#### An 82-Bed Residential Treatment Program for Women Who are Transitioning from State Prison to Parole.

##### Initial Intensive Four-Month Program

- Individual and Group Counseling
- Modified Therapeutic Community Setting
- Gender-Responsive, Trauma-Informed

##### Subsequent Transition Program

- Re-entry activities such as treatment passes and job search
- Community re-entry assistance with financial resources, recent work skills and experience

##### Additional Programs and Services

- Individual, group and family counseling
- Individual and group therapy
- Family reunification services
- Educational services
- Vocational services

#### More About CCTRP

Los Angeles Centers for Alcohol and Drug Abuse (L.A. CADA), in collaboration with the State of California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, operates the Custody to Community Transitional Reentry Program (CCTRP) in Santa Fe Springs, CA.

The CCTRP allows eligible inmates committed to State prison to serve the remainder of their sentence in the community. The program provides a wide range of rehabilitative and reentry services that assist participants with substance abuse treatment and recovery, employment, education, housing, family reunification, and social support. These services are aimed at providing participants a safe and gradual reentry, and helps them reclaim their place as productive individuals while improving their family relationships and socio-economic status through employment and education.



CCTRP participants remain under the jurisdiction of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation and are supervised by the on-site correctional staff while in the community. Under CCTRP, one day of participation counts one day of incarceration in State prison.
