POSITION SUMMARY:

This position will provide clinical supervision to all Staff and Interns providing direct Alcohol and Other Drugs (AOD) specific services. Such services may include intake assessment, group, individual, family therapy, crisis intervention, referrals, and collaboration with outside service providers.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's degree in Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapist or related Human Services required.
- Licensed by the State of California as LCSW, LMFT or license eligible.
- Minimum of two years of relevant clinical treatment experience and two years as a Supervisor in a licensed residential drug treatment program.
- Ability to demonstrate in-depth knowledge of addiction, recovery, codependency, and family systems theory, and treatment skills.
- Training in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT), Motivational Interviewing (MI) and ASAM required at time of hire.
- Ability to obtain an "NPI" Number and "C" Number by time of hire.
- Knowledge of chemical dependency, substance abuse, personal dynamics of the substance abuser, and trauma informed/gender responsive treatment preferred.
- Ability to be sensitive to trauma and gender on behalf of the program preferred.
- Ability to provide leadership and work effectively with a multidisciplinary team.
- Excellent communication skills, including good writing skills.
- Ability to exercise good judgement and discretion.
- Ability to work well in a team environment.
- Knowledge in health and safety standards for residential facilities.
- Valid California Driver's License and Identification required.
- Proof of personal auto insurance may be required if position requires driving.
- Must be able to pass a criminal history background screening (Live-scan), as well as maintain a current First Aid/CPR Certification, physical exam, and Tuberculosis test results.
